## Video Paper Guidelines

---

Video papers should adhere to the following guidelines:

1. The paper should be single-spaced typed, 12-point font (including name, date, and period which should appear at the top right hand side of the paper)
2. The margins should be no larger than 1" on all sides.
3. The paper should be between 1½ and 2 pages in length.
4. The first five paragraphs should address five things that you learned from the video.  
**NO SPACE SHOULD BE PLACED BETWEEN PARAGRAPHS.**
5. The sixth paragraph should be a commentary about what you thought about the video as a whole.
6. Two student-drawn color pictures directly related to the video should be included (no downloaded jpgs, gifs, etc.) The diagrams can be as wide as the page and no taller than 2" high. The text should support the diagrams, not vise-versa.
7. The diagram(s) should immediately appear after the paragraph that references them.
8. Notes taken during presentation should be stapled to the back of the paper.
9. There will be a deduction of 5 points for each typographical error or misspelling.
