

Physics Café @ Loyola

Physics Café is a program which allows Loyola's AP Physics students to tutor freshman physics students (FPS). AP Physics "tutors" can volunteer for various time slots to tutor FPS. FPS can arrive at any of these time slots to ask general or specific questions, ask for help with problem solving, etc.

Guidelines:

1. For every one (1) session* that you tutor, you can earn 1 extra credit point up to a maximum of 25 extra credit points that will be added to your personal point total.
2. For every two (2) sessions that you tutor, you can earn back to a maximum of 90% credit on a late assignment.
3. Of course, you can help a fellow freshman student just to help out with no expected reward.
4. Physics Café will begin 15 minutes after the beginning of lunch. You may bring your lunch while you tutor.

How do I sign-up for Physics Cafe?

Just show up on any of the Physics Café days. I will have a sign-in/sign-out sheet on a clip board by my computer. Simply sign in, sign out, and fill out the "reason" box (i.e. extra credit, fix late assignment). That's it!
